




Black History Month Education Celebration

How it works!



Students will ...

four category rounds for each team to participate in throughout the month of February. The student teams will receive a score for each category.

The top two teams ...

with the highest combined category scores, per grade groups, should advance to the Trivia Bowl finals! Prizes should be awarded to the final teams. All teams should receive recognition for their participation.






The Challenge Process


A Celebration of Achievement
